

***Elevate Your Online Instruction - A Workshop Approach to Blended Learning (10 PD Course)***

*Dates: July 27th, 29th and 30th (Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday), 8am to 11am*

*Target audience: This course is designed for participants who already have some proficiency in creating screencast lessons and using online platforms to deliver instruction (Zoom/Google Meet along with a learning management system such as Google Classroom, Schoology, Canvas, etc).*

This course is designed to introduce tools and strategies for creating an effective blended/online learning environment that ***can be used no matter what the return to school model.*** In order to experience a blended learning environment as a student, you will engage with the courses three modules in both synchronous and asynchronous manners. The structure will be as follows: prepare for the module (asynchronous), attend module 'live' session (synchronous) via Zoom, then complete lesson activity (asynchronous). The course will be housed on Google Classroom in order to provide easy dissemination of materials as well as feedback on submission of assignments/products. The workshop approach builds in time for instruction/explanation with plenty of time for applying what you've learned to build usable lessons/materials for fall. *Upon completion of the course, participants will have shifted a lesson/unit they currently use face-to-face into a blended learning environment lesson/unit.*
